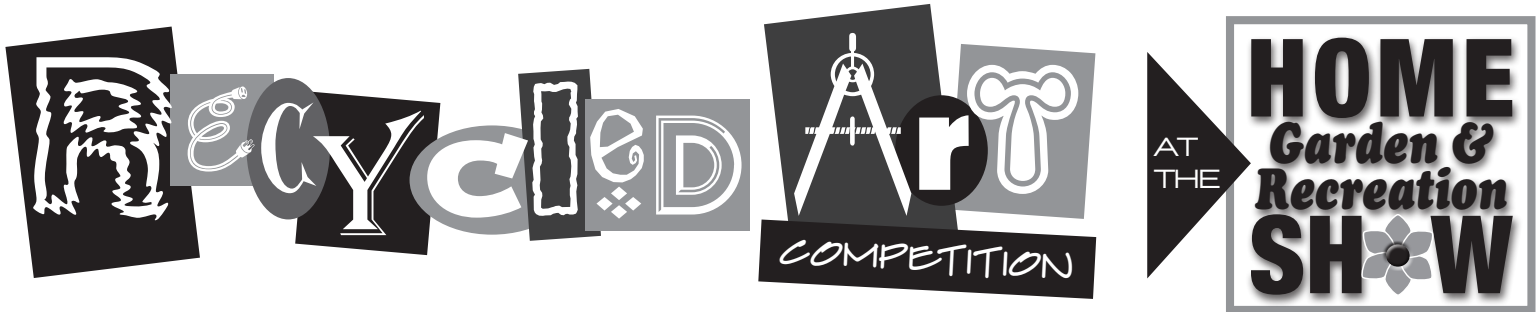

Items must be made from recyclable material (Steel, aluminum, newspaper, cardboard, etc.) Glass is not preferred. No perishable items please.
